Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter is in response to the report, "Proposed Sewer Connection Locations for Golden State Warriors Development Project @ Mission Bay Blocks 29-32" (BKF Engineers, April 13, 2015). The Report requests approval from the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) for proposed points of connection for the Golden State Warriors Development Project (GSW Project). The Report proposes splitting the GSW Project's projected peak sanitary flows as follows: 160 gallons per minute (gpm) to the SFPUC's Mission Bay Sanitary Sewer Pump Station (SSPS) and 586 gpm to the SFPUC's Mariposa Pump Station (Mariposa PS).

Preliminary SFPUC findings indicate that splitting the GSW Project's projected peak sanitary flows as proposed is an acceptable approach. This approach keeps projected peak sanitary flows directed to SSPS from the GSW Project below the flows projected for the originally entitled office campus. The existing and future public infrastructure serving the north portion of the GSW Project site, including the SSPS, has been designed and built to accommodate those projected peak flows.

However, the projected peak sanitary flows directed to the Mariposa PS from the GSW Project are far greater than the peak sanitary flows projected for the originally entitled office campus. Future improvements to the Mariposa PS have already been initiated by the SFPUC to accommodate these new projections. I would like to meet with the Golden State Warriors team to discuss the proportional contribution of the GSW Project to the planned Mariposa PS improvement projects.
