

LOCAL ACCESS PLAN – PROPOSED SIGNS AND PCO DUTIES (7-15-15)

PERMANENT SIGNS

Location 1: (Owens and 7th Streets)

Signage: Southbound 7th Street signed as “Arena” and eastbound signage Owens signed as “UCSF Hospital”

Location 2: Mariposa Offramp at (new) Owens

Signage: Right lane signed as “Arena”, middle (though) and left (through/left) lane signed as “UCSF Hospital”

EVENT SIGNS

Location 1 (Owens Street/Mission Bay Drive)

Signage: Southbound Owens Street signed as “No Arena Traffic/ Local Access and Through Traffic Access and I-280 Only” with arrow towards eastbound Mission Bay Boulevard South for “Warriors Arena.”

PCO: Guides Warriors Arena traffic towards Mission Bay Boulevard South. Does not screen individual cars heading south onto Owens Street.

Location 2 (Owens Street/Sixteenth Street)

Signage: Northbound Owens Street signed as “No Arena Traffic/ Local Access and Through Traffic Only” with arrow towards eastbound Sixteenth Street for “Warriors Arena.” Southbound Owens Street signed “Local Access and I-280 Only” with arrow towards eastbound Sixteenth Street for “Warriors Arena.”

PCO: Guides Warriors Arena traffic to eastbound Sixteenth Street, and holds back traffic on Sixteenth Street to allow cars on southbound Owens Street headed to the hospital to cross Sixteenth Street. Does not screen individual cars heading north or south onto Owens Street.

Comment [PAA1]: This seems fine: why would anyone wanting through access go on Owens when there’s capacity on westbound 16th?

Location 3 (Owens Street/Mariposa Street)

Signage: Northbound Owens Street signed as “Local Access Only” with arrow towards eastbound Mariposa Street for “Warriors Arena.”

PCO: Guides Warriors Arena traffic to eastbound Mariposa Street. Does not screen individual cars heading north onto Owens Street.

Comment [PAA2]: This seems fine: why would anyone wanting through access go on Owens when there’s capacity on westbound Mariposa?

Location 4 (Fourth Street and Mission Bay Boulevard South)

Signage: Southbound Fourth Street signed as “Local Access Only” with arrow towards eastbound Mission Bay Boulevard South for “Warriors Arena.”

PCO: Guides Warriors Arena traffic towards Mission Bay Boulevard South, and screens individual cars heading onto Fourth Street, based on protocol to be established with UCSF.

Location 5 (Fourth Street and Nelson Rising Lane)

Signage: Fourth Street signed as “Local Access Only” with arrow towards eastbound Nelson Rising Lane for “Warriors Arena.”

PCO: Screens individual cars that slip through the PCO at Fourth Street and Mission Bay Boulevard South, based on protocol to be established with UCSF. Cars without proper credentials sent eastbound on Nelson Rising Lane.

Location 6 (Fourth Street/Sixteenth Street)

Signage: Northbound and southbound Fourth Street signed as “Local Access Only” with arrow towards eastbound Sixteenth Street for “Warriors Arena.”

PCO: Holds back traffic on Sixteenth Street to allow cars on southbound Fourth Street headed to the hospital to cross Sixteenth Street. Does not screen individual cars heading onto Fourth Street.

Location 7 (Fourth Street/Mariposa Street)

Signage: Northbound Fourth Street signed as “Local Access Only” with arrow towards eastbound Mariposa Street for “Warriors Arena.”

PCO: Guides Warriors Arena traffic to eastbound Mariposa Street, and holds back traffic on Mariposa Street to allow northbound cars on Minnesota Street headed to the hospital to cross Mariposa Street.
