Eastern Neighborhoods August 24, 2015




#### **Project Elements**

- Last met July 21, 2015
  - 18,064 seat multi-purpose arena
  - 520,000 leasable sf of office/lab
  - Up to 125,000 leasable sf of retail
  - 3.2 acres of plazas and open space,
     triggers construction of 5.5 acre Bayfront
     Park
  - 950 Parking spaces
